## Errata for *2012G Beaubourg*

Applies to patterns dated before 12/4/12:

On page 4, under *INSTRUCTIONS* -> *BACK* -> *Shoulder Shaping* ->

Row 2 should read as follows:

Row 2: Yo, knit to last 3 stitches, turn. [yarn overs do not count as sts and will be worked together with the next st to close holes left when work was turned]

The first two "Next Row"s should read as follows:

Next row (RS): Purl, picking up yo's and p2tog working each yo together with the next stitch as p2tog.

Next row: BO 51 (54, 57, 60, 63) stitches loosely knitwise, place locking marker in edge, knit to end, working each yo together with the next stitch as ssk.

On page 4, under *INSTRUCTIONS* -> *FRONT* -> *Left Shoulder & Neckline Shaping* ->

Rows 1 & 2 should read as follows:

Row 1 (RS): Sl 2 stitches purlwise with yarn in front, p65 (68, 71, 74, 77), turn, leaving remaining 80 (85, 88, 93, 96) stitches unworked at end of rnd. [67 (70, 73, 76, 79) sts remain in work.]

Row 2 (WS): Yo, knit to last 3 stitches, turn. [yarn overs do not count as sts and will be worked together with the next st to close holes left when work was turned]

Rows 13 & 14 should read as follows:

Row 13: Yo, purl to marked center stitch, working each yo together with the next stitch as p2tog, then purl center stitch. Turn.

Row 14: Loosely BO 17 (18, 19, 19) stitches knitwise, knit to 3 stitches before yo on previous row. [57 (60, 63, 66, 69) stitches remain for left shoulder] Turn.

On page 5, under *INSTRUCTIONS* -> *FRONT* -> *Left Shoulder & Neckline Shaping* ->

"Next Row" should read as follows:

Next row: Ssk, knit to end, working each yo together with the next stitch as ssk. [51 (54, 57, 60, 63) stitches]

On page 5, under *INSTRUCTIONS* -> *FRONT* -> *Right Shoulder & Neckline Shaping* ->

Row 13 should read as follows:

Row 13: Yo, knit to end, working each yo together with the next stitch as ssk, turn.

"Next Row" should read as follows:

Next row: P2tog, purl to end, working each yo together with the next stitch as p2tog. [51 (54, 57, 60, 63) stitches remain]
