



MANOS DEL URUGUAY

Errata for *2013K Gradiente*

Applies only to patterns dated before 12/28/13:

In the **NOTES** section, the following yarn requirements have been clarified:

* Each hank of Manos del Uruguay LACE yarn is wrapped approx. 270 times around the hank.

If making 2 balls: *Colors A and C:* wind 60 wraps from the hank into the first (smallest) ball, then wind the remaining yarn into a second (largest), center-pull ball.

Color B: wind 35 wraps from the hank into the first (smallest) ball, then wind the remaining yarn into a second (largest), center-pull ball.

If making 3 balls: *Colors A and C:* wind 60 wraps from the hank into the first (smallest) ball, wind 90 wraps from the hank into the second (medium) ball, then wind the remaining yarn (approx. 120 wraps) into a third (largest) ball.

Color B: wind 35 wraps from the hank into the first (smallest) ball, wind 90 wraps from the hank into the second (medium) ball, then wind the remaining yarn (approx. 145 wraps) into a third (largest) ball.

Applies only to patterns dated before 7/1/13:

On p. 2, middle of right column, it should read:

First Stripe

With smaller needle and 3 strands of Color A held together (1 strand from each ball), cast on 240 stitches.

Knit 3 rows.

Change to larger needle and work Diagonal Pattern for **8** rows, ending after a WS row.

Cut 1 strand from the smallest ball of Color A.

On p. 3, top of right column, it should read:

Seventh Stripe

Join 1 strand from the smallest ball of Color C.

Work in Diagonal Pattern using 3 strands of Color C for **9** rows, ending after a RS row.

Change to smaller needle and knit 3 rows. Bind off all stitches knitwise on RS.

Applies only to patterns dated before 4/15/13

On p. 2, bottom of right column, it should read:

Fourth Stripe

Join 1 strand from the smallest ball of Color B.

Work in Diagonal Pattern using 3 strands of Color **B** for 8 rows, ending after a WS row.

Cut 1 strand from the smallest ball of Color B.
